Moffett and John will comply with NSF data policy which requires the collection and submission of all data resulting from our incubation experiments and analyses. They will also report the appropriate meta-data (data describing methods and protocols). Data will be submitted to the Biological and Chemical Oceanography Data Management Office (<http://www.bco-dmo.org>) at WHOI. In keeping with NSF policy, all data from this project will be submitted within 2 years of completion of the 2018 cruise. Moffett will coordinate with the University of Washington on data submission activities whenever that enhances the value of the product to the community. Much of the data is generated from laboratory experiments and process studies. This will also be submitted to BCO-DMO, which is familiar with such data sets and their associated meta data as a result of experimentation-focused initiatives like Ocean Acidification.
